Frequently Asked Questions

How do I register? Click on <https://membership.sportstg.com/regofrm.cgi?formID=71411> to register. Registrations close strictly at **9.00am on Monday 18 September 2017**. All players (including 2016/17 Keilor Thunder players) must register in order to trial. There is a one off, \$10 fee (regardless of how many trials you attend) which is payable when you register online. You must pay for the registration to be complete.

Where are the try-outs held? At Keilor Basketball Stadium (Stadium Drive, Keilor Park, 3042).

What do I bring to trials? Players are asked to bring a light and dark top, a drink bottle and a basketball with their name on it.

What do I do once I arrive? Please arrive at least 15 minutes before your scheduled trial time. Go to the foyer and see one of the people sitting at a desk. They will sign you in and point you in the right direction. If you are a player from another VJBL Association, you **MUST** bring along a completed Permission to Train Form, which can be found on the VJBL website.

Are parents/guardians and spectators allowed to watch trials? No. Only players, coaches and Keilor Thunder officials are allowed to watch trials. Parents/guardians and spectators are allowed to stay in the stadium foyer whilst trials are running.

What happens after each phase of trials? After each phase of trials, not all players will be invited back to the next phase. Players will be notified via email if they have been successful or not in making the next phase of trials.

- After Phase 1, players will be notified on Tuesday 26 September 2017.
- After Phase 2, players will be notified on Tuesday 10 October 2017.
- After Phase 3, players will be notified if they have made a team or not on Monday 16 October 2017 (some players may be asked to attend a fourth trial, if necessary).

Can I receive feedback about my trial? Due to limited resources, we will only be in a position to provide feedback to those who make Phase 3 of trials.

What happens if I am offered a spot on a team? If you are offered a spot on Monday 16 October 2017, you will have until 5.00pm on Wednesday 18 October 2017 to accept or decline the offer. This can be done via return email. You will then be sent all the relevant information with regards to fees, uniform, coaching staff, expectations, start dates and so on. If you are selected, it's important to note the following:

- A full commitment to attend all games and training sessions is mandatory.
- Unlike Junior Domestic, you may not receive an equal amount of court time. This will be at the discretion of the coach.
- Once you accept your position, it is expected that you pay your fees on time and in full. There will be no payment plans or reduction of fees. Fees are not refundable under any circumstance. Fees cover coaching costs, training costs, court hire, insurance and administration costs. For new players, there will also be an additional cost for uniform.
- Any injuries are to be notified to your team manager ASAP.
- If you need to raise a complaint for any reason, please notify your team manager, who will then notify the Association, if they deem it necessary.
- It is expected that you will be supportive of your coach at all times.
- Once teams are finalised, there will be a mandatory meeting for all parents and players.
