



VJBL UNDER 14 NATIONAL CLUBS RULE

Selection Criteria

Basketball Australia allocates the number of bids each state is entitled to on an annual basis. This allocation is done based upon the results of the previous year's National Club Championship.

The allocation given to Basketball Victoria includes one automatic invitation that Basketball Victoria extend to the winner of the Country Victorian Championship (or similar) for that particular year.

All teams who compete in the Victorian Championship League are eligible to qualify under this selection criteria.

Once BA has released the number of spots for Victorian teams, the bids will be extended to teams as follows

3 Positions: Guaranteed: 1st Ashe, 1st Watson and BVC Country Championship Winner.

4 Positions: Guaranteed: 1st Ashe, 1st Watson and BVC Country Championship Winner. Only if teams haven't played in Grading, a Challenge Match will be played to determine the final position. (2nd Ashe vs 2nd Watson)

5 Positions: Guaranteed: Top Two in Ashe, Top Two in Watson and BVC Country Championship Winner.

6 Positions: Guaranteed: Top Two in Ashe, Top Two in Watson and BVC Country Championship Winner. Only if teams haven't played in Grading, a Challenge Match will be played to determine the final position. (3rd Ashe vs 3rd Watson)

VJBL Administration

The VJBL administration will select teams from Victorian Championships Competition at the completion of Round 9 (Halfway point of the competition).

The VJBL will only allow players participating in this competition before or at this point to nominate for the Club Championships.

VJBL Administration Staff holds the right to use their discretion in exceptional circumstances throughout this process including the selection of additional teams to replace interstate or Victorian withdrawals.

Ranking of teams will be finalized at Basketball Australia's request. VJBL Administration have the right to use their discretion in exceptional circumstances throughout the process.
